Hafjell Alpine Resort is one of the most popular ski resorts in Norway. Located just 15 minutes north of Lillehammer, Hafjell is one of Norway's most accessible ski destinations. Hafjell hosted events both during the Lillehammer 1994 Olympics and the Lillehammer 2016 Youth Olympics. The resort also hosts annual WC/EC alpine events, and hosted the Norwegian National Snowboard Championships in 2015.

As we work to prepare all aspects of what we hope will be a great event for the Snowboard Para Sports Community, this temporarily Invitation should help all teams to plan ahead. An updated version of this invitation will be published by January 15th at the World Para Snowboard web site and sent to all the teams.

The Para Nordic World Cup is a test event for the World Para Snowboard World Championship 2021.

With the World Para Snow Sports Championship and the test events, we aim to develop Hafjell and Lillehammer as a resort for para snow sports.

Travel to and from Hafjell

Hafjell is easily accessible via Oslo International Airport (OSL). Trains run frequently between OSL and Lillehammer, and it takes 1 h 43 min. From the Lillehammer train station, there will be buses directly to the Hafjell.

Going by car to Hafjell takes approximately $2\ h$ $15\ min$ from OSL. Going from Oslo, the capital of Norway, to Hafjell takes $2\ h$ $30\ min$ by car.

For teams and athletes arriving at OSL, and wish to continue by train to Lillehammer, we might - on request - provide transport of the equipment from the airport to the hotel at Hafjell.

All teams and athletes arriving by train, will be picked up at the Lillehammer train station.













All visitors to Norway will need a valid passport. A Visa is necessary for some countries. If a Visa is required, teams are responsible to arrange Visas in a timely manner for all accredited team members. 
Travel times by train from OSL to Lillehammer is only 1 h 43 min. From Lillehammer train station to Hafjell it it is only 18 min.

Hotel, accommodation packages and meals

All athletes and coaches will stay at the official event hotel, Hafjell Hotel, conveniently located a couple of minutes by bus to Hafjell Resort.

An accommodation package, at affordable prices, including accommodations, meal plan, transport and other benefits will be shared with the teams by January $15^{\rm th}$.
